Disciples' Group: The next meeting will take place on Monday 2nd July at 7.45pm in the lounge. Any queries please contact Mike Miller.



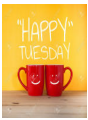
Deacons: The next meeting will be on Thursday 5th July at 7.30pm in the lounge.
